## Bay scallops may only be harvested in state waters from the following areas:

**Gulf County (Includes St. Joseph Bay):** From Mexico Beach Canal in Bay County to the westernmost point of St. Vincent Island in Franklin County.

Franklin County - northwestern Taylor County (includes Carrabelle, Lanark and St. Marks): From the westernmost point of St. Vincent Island in Franklin County to Rock Island near the mouth of the Fenholloway River in Taylor County.

**Fenholloway through Suwanee rivers** (includes Keaton Beach and Steinhatchee): From east of Rock Island near the mouth of the Fenholloway River in Taylor County and north of Alligator Pass daybeacon #4 near the mouth of the Suwannee River in Levy County.

\*Note: Different bag limit June 15-June 30.

## Levy, Citrus & Hernando counties (includes Cedar Key, Crystal River & Homosassa):

From south of Alligator Pass daybeacon #4 near the mouth of the Suwannee River in Levy County and north of the Hernando – Pasco county line.

**Pasco County:** From south of the Hernando – Pasco county line and north of the Anclote Key Lighthouse in northern Pinellas County, and all waters of the Anclote River.
