EXEMPTION I	<b>Honorably Discharged Military Veteran</b> – Beginning July 1, 2014, the income requirement for a restricted species endorsement shall be waived for a period of one year from the end of the current license year (June 30 <sup>th</sup> ) for any Florida resident military veteran who applies to the Commission within 48 months of an honorable discharge from any branch of the United States Armed Forces, the Reserves, the Florida National Guard or the						
	Coast Guard. This exemption is allowed one time per military enlistment and only on an <b>individual SPL</b> .						
	New RS Endorsement Application - A copy of the discharge documentation is required						
	This exemption is allowed one time per military enlistment. To renew the endorsement, submit the standard Restricted Species (RS) Endorsement Application.
